Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 319

The new 319 is the baby of the Jeanneau range and with a hull length of 29ft 6in, this is definitely a pocket cruiser. She does boast generous beam and freeboard, which gives her good internal volume, but also makes her look slightly dumpy on the water. She promises to be a versatile performer, however, and comes with the option of a standard fin keel or a stubbier winged keel and centreboard combination. Remarkably for such a small yacht she comes with wheel steering. The interior feels spacious and comfortable and there are two fully enclosed cabins.

The trend towards bigger production yachts shows no sign of easing up and Bavaria's new C65 underlines this in style. This is the biggest yacht Bavaria has ever built and, although she's an out and out cruising yacht, she looks impressively sleek, with that long waterline offsetting the generous freeboard. She comes with twin rudders and a decent sized rig. All sail controls are push button and there is a full sized dinghy garage underneath. Down below she's very light and luxurious. Naturally, she's equipped with all the bells and whistles you'd expect, including washing machine, dishwasher and flat screen TV.

Dufour Grand Large 360

Dufour's new 360 Grand Large sits above the 310 in the range and is a handy addition to the range. Designed, as all her sisters in the range are, by Umberto Felci, this smart little yacht offers Dufour's usual blend of cruising comfort combined with sprightly performance. In common with the larger yachts in the range, the 360 has a barbecue and sink area concealed behind the seats aft and also a much larger bathing platform than her predecessor. Down below, the standard layout features two double berths with a single heads and shower compartment. The boat also introduces a new range of fabrics and wood finishes for 2018.
